Tallahassee International Airport is owned and operated by the City of Tallahassee and serves a 100-mile market radius. Three major airlines provide daily non-stop flights to: Atlanta, Charlotte, Dallas-Fort Worth, Fort Lauderdale, Miami, Orlando and Tampa with connections to virtually every major destination world-wide.

The Tallahassee market area has more than 1.4 million in total population. TLH Airport serves Tallahassee and its 32 surrounding counties in North Florida, South Georgia and Alabama. Tallahassee International Airport accounts for 32% of air passenger travel in the Northwest Florida region.

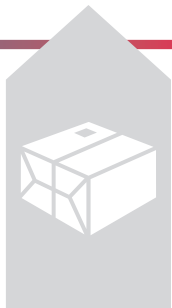




Location

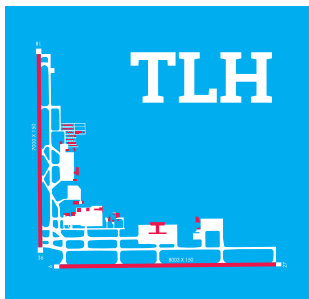
FedEx Air, Ground & Freight: TLH is the primary carrier of freight for the region with significant capacity for expansion.



Economic Impact

The Airport has approximately 35 on-site aviation-related tenants that contribute to its annual economic impact with 900 acres available for further development. Florida Department of Transportation 2014 Economic Impact Study shows the total contributions from airport operations to the region's economy through direct and indirect sources is \$399 million annually.

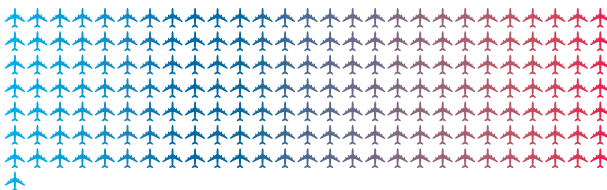
